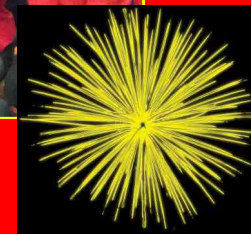
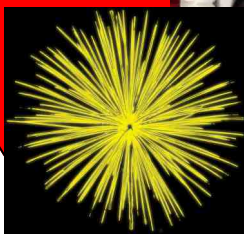


## Y4 KJ Class Assembly Electricity

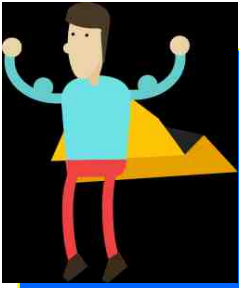
# Y5 SPACE HOME LEARNING

McKenzie and Prabhpreet are learning new skills in Maths.



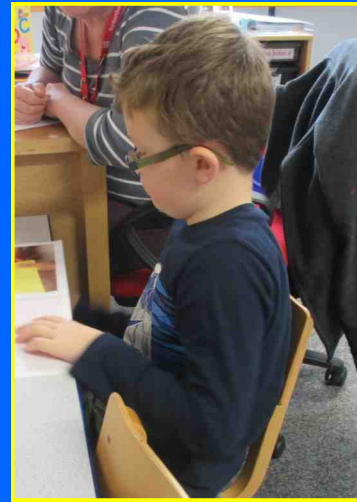
These children are stretching their brains by learning to read and play music.



Reception are getting better at listening to and responding to a story.



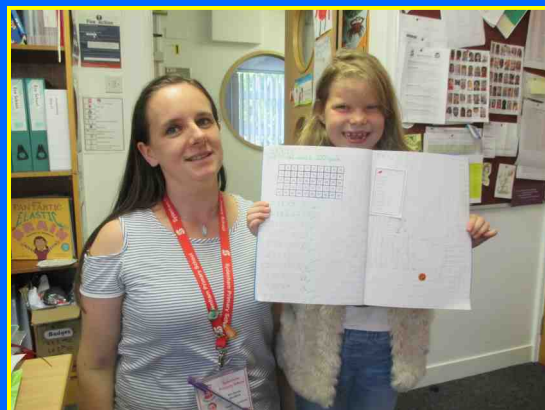
Logan and Daniel are learning how to write an exciting adventure story.



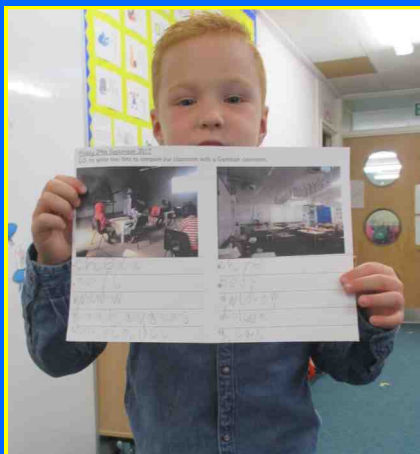
Jack is making fantastic progress with his reading.



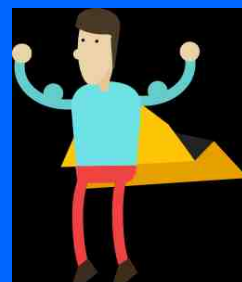
Arun and Ardawan are working as talk partners to develop their mathematical understanding.

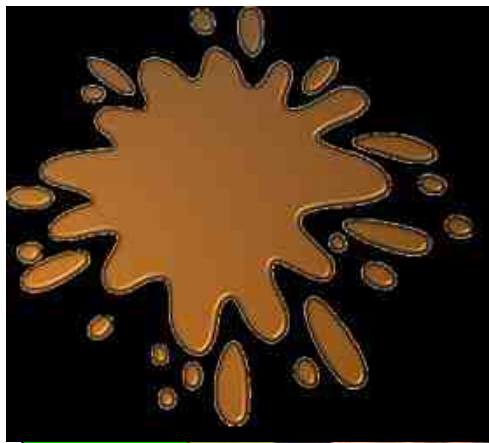


Lottie has really impressed Mrs Shaddick by using a number line to solve some tricky calculations.

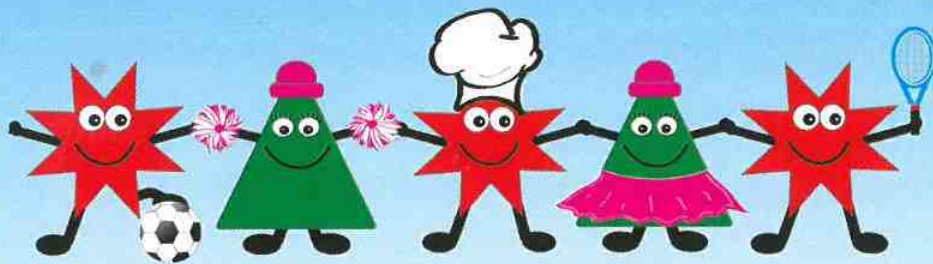
